EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Bill amends the *University of Ottawa Act, 1965* to change the composition of the board of governors. The number of members appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council is reduced from four to two. Four persons appointed by the Student Federation, and two persons appointed by the Graduate Students' Association are added to the Board. The maximum number of Board members (32) is unchanged.

NOTE EXPLICATIVE

Le projet de loi modifie la loi intitulée *University of Ottawa Act, 1965* en ce qui concerne la composition du Bureau des gouverneurs. Le nombre de membres nommés par le lieutenant-gouverneur en conseil est ramené de quatre à deux. Quatre personnes nommées par la Fédération étudiante et deux personnes nommées par l'Association des étudiant(e)s diplômé(e)s siègent dorénavant au Bureau. Le nombre maximal de membres (32) reste le même.

Bill 5**1999****An Act to amend the University of Ottawa Act, 1965**

University incorporated

Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:

1. Section 3 of the *University of Ottawa Act, 1965* is repealed and the following substituted:

3. The Board is hereby continued as a corporation without share capital consisting of its members as determined under section 9, to be known in French as “Université d’Ottawa” and in English as “University of Ottawa”.

2. Section 9 of the Act is repealed and the following substituted:

9. There shall be a board of governors of the University of not more than 32 members, consisting of,

- (a) the Rector, who is a member by virtue of his or her office;
- (b) two persons appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council;
- (c) two persons appointed by the Senate from among its own members elected under clause 15 (1) (d);
- (d) two persons appointed by the Alumni Association from among its own members;
- (e) four persons appointed by the Student Federation from among its own members;
- (f) two persons appointed by the Graduate Students’ Association from among its own members;
- (g) eight persons appointed by the Council of Administration of Saint Paul University; and
- (h) such other persons as may be appointed by the Board.

Transition

3. (1) A person who is a member of the board of governors of the University of Ottawa immediately before this Act comes into force continues to be a member of the Board on the day this Act comes into force.
