# An Act respecting the City of Ottawa

#### Preamble

The council of the City of Ottawa ("City Council") has applied for special legislation in respect of the matters set out in this Act.

It is appropriate to grant the application.

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Ontario, enacts as follows:



### By-laws re taxicabs

1. In a by-law passed to license, regulate and govern owners and drivers of taxicabs used for hire, City Coun-

cil may define the area or areas of the City to which the by-law applies.



#### Commencement

3. This Act comes into force on the day it receives Royal Assent.

#### Short title

4. The short title of this Act is the City of Ottawa Act (Taxicabs), 2001.
