Moving over to the title, at this time I will be asking, shall the title of the bill be carried? On this section, any debate? Seeing none, are the members ready to vote? Yes? All those in favour, please raise your hands. All those opposed, please raise your hands. I declare the title of the bill carried.

At this time, I will be asking the members, shall Bill 152 be carried as a whole? Any debate? Seeing none, are the members ready to vote? Yes? All those in favour, please raise your hands. All those opposed, please raise your hands. Seeing that, I declare that Bill 152 be carried.
